(FY 1999 Appropriations Request for the Tohono O'odham Fire Department)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-076

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres and
23,000 members provides services to all areas of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, there is a need to increase equipment and related operating expenses;
and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Fire Department has identified specific areas of
proposed increased equipment and related operating expenses; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the
Tohono O'odham Fire Department in their request for funding in the
amount of \$6,530,121.00 to provide for increased equipment and
related operating expenses.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Appropriations Committee is hereby
authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate
agencies and members and committees of Congress.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD
day of FEBRUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of
1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1(j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


