4	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for
5	the elderly members of the Nation; and
6	WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made
7	possible in part by the Older American's Act of 1965 as amended; and
8	WHEREAS, there is a direct reimbursement from the Department of Agriculture
9	to the Nation for meals served. This reimbursement, as Cash In Lieu
10	of Commodities is in two Accounts with the Nation; and
11	WHEREAS, according to the Older American's Act, the funds can only be used to
12	purchase food for the elderly program and a budget has been
13	submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Senior
14	Services for this purpose.
15	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
16	does hereby approve and authorize expenditures in accordance with
17	the attached budget and that funds not expended in the FY 1997 budget
18	be added to the present budget.
19	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
20	reimbursement money from USDA for meals served to the elderly
21	under Title III and Title VI be segregated from the general fund to
22	
23	ensure that the funds are utilized only for the purchase of food for the
24	elderly program.
