

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1998 USDA Reimbursement Funds - Account #13-1425 and 11-1425)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-081**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for the elderly members of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made possible in part by the Older American's Act of 1965 as amended; and**

**WHEREAS, there is a direct reimbursement from the Department of Agriculture to the Nation for meals served. This reimbursement, as Cash In Lieu of Commodities is in two Accounts with the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, according to the Older American's Act, the funds can only be used to purchase food for the elderly program and a budget has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Senior Services for this purpose.**


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve and authorize expenditures in accordance with the attached budget and that funds not expended in the FY 1997 budget be added to the present budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the reimbursement money from USDA for meals served to the elderly under Title III and Title VI be segregated from the general fund to ensure that the funds are utilized only for the purchase of food for the elderly program.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 23RD, day of FEBRUARY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


