**RESOLUTION NO. 98-085**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") covers an area in excess of 2.8 million acres and has a population of 23,000 people who are widely dispersed throughout four separate reservation lands; and**

**WHEREAS, the members of the Nation face unnecessary threats to their lives and health due to the lack of adequate emergency medical response; and**

**WHEREAS, the current EMS program, funded in 1992 by Indian Health Services under a special allocation of \$423,000, has not seen an increase in funding levels and yet increase in service calls have increased substantially; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation and its membership desires an improvement of Emergency Medical Services by increasing the funding level of the current program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby urgently request that Congress appropriate \$1,676,821 in accordance with the attached proposal to assist the Nation in meeting the demands of adequate Emergency Medical Services.**


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the appropriate Officers of the Nation are hereby authorized and directed to bring this request to the appropriate members and committees of Congress.**


