

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving FY 98 Attorney Contract for Donnelly A. Dybus, Esq. to serve  
as a Conflict Attorney)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-087**

**WHEREAS, there are no other attorneys to handle conflicts which the Nation's Advocate Program is not ethically allowed to handle in the increasing needs of tribal members for legal representation in civil and criminal matters; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program wishes to retain Donnelly A. Dybus to be appointed to represent clients with conflicts of interest who can not be represented by the Nation's Advocate Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program wishes to retain Donnelly A. Dybus as Conflict Attorney for the twelve (12) months of FY 98, and projects the cost of such services at \$20,000.00; and**

**WHEREAS, the Advocate Program has presented a contract for Donnelly A. Dybus which confirms and ratifies the terms and conditions related to future services, a copy of which is attached; and**

**WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by the Legislative Council of an Attorney Contract with Donnelly A. Dybus on such terms.**

**NOW ,THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 1. The Legislative Council ratifies and approves the Conflict Attorney Contract for Donnelly A. Dybus in the form attached hereto, for the period of October 01, 1997 through September 30, 1998 in the amount not to exceed \$20,000.00.**

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3                   **2. Funding for the Conflict Attorney Contract for Donnelly A. Dybus**  
4                   **shall be provided under the operating budget of the Advocate**  
5                   **Program for Fiscal Year 1998.**

13 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48**  
14 **Stat. 984).**


