WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council on 10 December 1990 did pass Resolution No. 447-90 (Amending the Restated Plan of Operation of the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority) which requires the Authority to submit for prior review and approval of the Legislative Council and each affected District any proposed utility easement; and

WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for a Right-of-Way to extend the Water

System to serve the San Xavier Multi-Purpose Education Facility

within San Xavier Community, San Xavier District, Tohono O'odham

Nation; and

WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents and pertinent information (attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council approved Resolution No. SXDC: 02-9719 which expedites all phases to establish the San Xavier MultiPurpose Education Building to include Right-of-Way Utility
Easements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the Right-of-Way as requested by TOUA to extend
