

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Permitting references to the Tohono O'odham Nation proposed in
La Ruta de Sonora Brochure)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-091

WHEREAS, at the invitation of the Cultural Preservation Committee, representatives of the Sonoran Institute did provide a presentation to the Legislative Council on the *La Ruta de Sonora* project, an ecotourism project;

WHEREAS, presented were the goals and ideals of the *La Ruta de Sonora* project: economically benefit local communities; generate dividends for conservation; educate tourists; and ensure responsible tourism; and

WHEREAS, the *La Ruta de Sonora* ecotourism project proposes to distribute brochures which makes general references to the Tohono O'odham Nation and are seeking approval by this Council; and

WHEREAS, Council representatives stressed concerns on the negative aspects of tourism and stressed the importance of protecting our culture, traditions, natural resources, and environment; and

WHEREAS, assurances were made that this project would not promote mass tourism, but would strive toward manageable tourism, and hopefully bring a modest, economic benefit to participating members, communities, and districts, as well as to educate tourists to respect areas of significance to the Tohono O'odham.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby permits references to the Tohono O'odham Nation, as amended, in the proposed brochure of the *La Ruta de Sonora* project.






