**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation"), through the Tohono O'odham  
Police Department, participates with the Pima County Sheriff's  
Department and other law enforcement agencies in the High Intensity  
Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the United States Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) has  
awarded \$6,451,678.00 for fiscal year 1998 to the Pima County Sheriff's  
Department to be allocated to member agencies of the Arizona  
Southwest Border HIDTA Program to be spent in accordance with  
ONDCP guidelines; and**

**WHEREAS, the allocation to the Tohono O'odham Police Department is in the  
amount of \$69,416.00, to be expended in accordance with an  
Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County, which allocates  
\$46,921.00 to the Nation's participation in the MANTIS (Metropolitan  
Area Narcotics Trafficking Interdiction Squad) program and  
\$22,495.00 to the Nation's participation in the BANN (Border Anti-  
Narcotics Network) program ; and**

**WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council has reviewed the proposed Intergovernmental Agreement and  
recommends its approval by the Legislative Council.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
approves the Intergovernmental Agreement with Pima County on  
HIDTA program funds for the Tohono O'odham Police Department,**

**authorizes the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation to sign it and to sign any other documents needed to receive or expend these funds, and authorizes the Tohono O'odham Police Department to expend the funds in accordance with the terms of the Intergovernmental Agreement.**


**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5TH day of MARCH, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,112.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 190.0 NOT VOTING; and 625.0 [12] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
