WHEREAS, "A Vision of Healing for our O'odham" is the theme for the Second Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference, because the loss of spirit and traditions among tribal nations is a plague that the O'odham is not immune to and it is the vision of empowerment through healing that is the focus of the conference; and

WHEREAS, the introduction and existence of social issues that afflict the O'odham such as gangs, substance abuse, teen pregnancy, child abuse/neglect, elder abuse/neglect, alcoholism, and domestic violence is evident that ours is a culture in confusion and that we as O'odham have moved further away from our Himdag; and

WHEREAS, there are O'odham who live with hope for a better future where culture and wellness are the essences of everyday existence, a future where O'odham survival is once more rooted in understanding and respecting one another; and

WHEREAS, the O'odham who share this hope, and in sincere spirit, want to provide a forum for all O'odham who choose to be proactive in strengthening their personal wellness; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Wellness Planning Committee has been active in informing and extending an invitation to all who share the concepts and focus of the Tohono O'odham Wellness conference to contribute to the healing and empowerment of the O'odham by participating in the conference; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council acknowledges the problems facing the everyday lives of the O'odham and strongly supports the efforts of the Second Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference; and

WHEREAS, the Health and Human Services and Budget & Finance Committees have reviewed the Tohono O'odham Wellness Budget and recommends approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves the budget in the amount of \$50,386.43 to support the Second Annual Tohono O'odham Wellness Conference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget amount of \$50,386.43 will be appropriated from the FY 97 Identified Savings.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5TH day of MARCH, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927,0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [08] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


