1 2 3 RESOLUTION NO. 98-100 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation receives funding from the State of Arizona 5 to provide employment and training to eligible Native Americans 6 residing within the boundaries of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and 7 WHEREAS, according to the funding requirements the Tohono O'odham Nation 8 is to submit a Job Training Plan every two (2) years; and 9 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation [TPA/NEW program has assessed existing 10 11 services and has reflected these changes to service delivery which will 12 improve the quality of services provided. 13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 14 that it does hereby approve the 1998-1999 Tohono O'odham Job 15 Training Plan and hereby authorizes the Chairman and any 16 designated official to wit to execute the plan and any related 17 documents. 18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>6TH.</u> 19 day of MARCH, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of **20** 1,577.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 350.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the 21 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18. 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs 22 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 23 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 24 25 Dennis Ramon.
