

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for monetary donation for Pima County Domestic Violence
Commission in the amount of \$12,000.00)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-106

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") covers an area in excess of 2.8 million acres and has a population of 23,000 people, with the majority of the Nation within Pima County; and

WHEREAS, members of the Nation face unnecessary threats to their lives due to acts of domestic violence which occur within the family unit; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 1998 the Pima County Domestic Violence Commission came before this council and presented the purpose of said commission; and

WHEREAS, on September 30, October 1 and 2, 1998 at the Double Tree Hotel in Tucson, the first annual statewide conference Communities United Against Abuse is planned and a donation in the amount of \$12,000.00 is being requested; and

WHEREAS, the Nation recognizes the need to assist in education, prevention and awareness to reducing and eliminating the Cycle of Violence for a healthier environment for its members.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT, RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby donates \$12,000.00 to the Pima County Domestic Violence Commission to support the first annual Communities United Against Abuse statewide conference.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the funding amount identified come from the FY-97 Savings.

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH, day of MARCH, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,100.0 FOR; 187.0 AGAINST; 451.0 NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
