WHEREAS, the following communities and districts requested funding of the specified Projects:

**Florence/Gu Achi Home Rehabilitation/Sanitation
Facilities**

**Pia Oik/Gu Vo Home Rehabilitation/Sanitation
Facilities**

**South Komelic, Little Tucson,
Artesia/Baboquivari Home Rehabilitation/Sanitation
Facilities**

**San Miguel/Chukut Kuk Home Rehabilitation/Sanitation
Facilities**

WHEREAS, the above listed communities and the recipients in those communities shall receive rehabilitation which is funded under HUD-ICDBG for 1997; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council agreed to provide \$56,621.00 of the Nation's funds to provide for the costs of foundations for recipients under the 1997 ICDBG project contingent upon the Nation receiving the grant funds from HUD; and

WHEREAS, the Nation received full funding under its 1997 ICDBG grant application, thus meeting the aforementioned contingency; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the Nation to implement the projects funded under this grant through the Executive branch through its Planning and Economic Development Department and the ICDBG program offices.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation does certify to appropriate and release \$56,621.00 to the Nation's ICDBG 1997 projects to provide for the cost of foundations for the homes to be rehabilitated under the 1997 ICDBG program, contingent upon receiving the grant award from HUD-ICDBG.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Nation's Executive Branch, through its Planning and Economic Development Department and ICDBG Program Office is endowed with the authority to implement these projects.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the source of funding for the appropriation shall be the FY 1997 Identified Savings.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18TH day of MARCH, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.681.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 57.0 NOT VOTING; and 189.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) & (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


