

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Acceptance of the Administration Budget and Reserve for Contingencies
Budget Modifications for the 1997 HUD ICDBG Grant)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-110

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation received a grant to address housing rehabilitation for member of the Nation and this grant was the 1997 ICDBG Grant, issued through the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the grant requires a budget modification to make the appropriate and necessary adjustments to the grant Administration budget reducing it by \$12,657.00 and to transfer that amount to the Reserve for Contingencies Budget pursuant to HUD imposed change which will increase the line item for Reserve for Contingencies by \$12,657.00 change; and

WHEREAS, the budget modification has been reviewed and approved by the following entities and committees of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council: Grants and Contracts in Accounting, the Executive Committee, the Commerce Committee and the Budget and Finance Committee; and

WHEREAS, these budget modifications are as follows: Reducing the Administration Budget by \$12,657.00 and adding \$12,657.00 to the Reserve for Contingencies line item to accommodate a budget adjustment imposed by HUD, and also adding new line item 751 Lease/Rentals.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves of the proposed budget modification to the 1997 ICDBG Grant in order to accommodate a change in the budget imposed by HUD.
