NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the submittal of the JTPA/NEW Summer Youth Employment Plan utilizing funds from the Department of Labor/DINAP for 1998.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JTPA/NEW Program will submit the plan along with a budget upon completion of committee review and approvals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, and any designated official are hereby authorized to execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or
