**RESOLUTION NO. 98-133**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is committed to enhancing  
the level of services available to Tohono O'odham children with  
disabilities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department, acting through the Head  
Start Program, has developed excellent working relationships with the  
Stanfield Elementary District #24 which serves Tohono O'odham  
children with disabilities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is in agreement that there  
should be a consistent collaborative relationship between local school  
districts and the Tohono O'odham Head Start so that Tohono O'odham  
children with disabilities may receive any and all services which they  
may require to meet their special needs.**


**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
that the Chairman of the Nation is authorized to enter into an  
Intergovernmental Agreement with the Stanfield Elementary District  
#24 for the purpose of collaborating with the school district to provide  
special services, in the least restrictive environment, for each Tohono  
O'odham child three to five years of age with a disability and that the  
Chairman may revise this agreement annually.**



(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48  
Stat. 984).**
