

5	grants for FY 1999 through the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona,
6	Weatherization Assistance Program; and
7	WHEREAS, the Weatherization Assistance is available to the Tohono O'odham
8	Nation to assist O'odham members who meet the eligibility
9	requirements; and
10	WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to request for

13	WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted
14	for review and approval a scope of work and budget that will conform
15	to the eligibility criteria set for in the funding and reporting
16	regulations.

18	1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby
19 20	authorize the officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to submit a
20	request for Weatherization Assistance Funding from the Inter
