

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amending Resolution No. 97-307)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-139

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council did through Resolution No. 97-307 authorize the submission of a grant application to the Department of Agriculture to fund a "Distance Learning" project; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Agriculture did fund said grant application.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation is authorized to receive and expend grant funds for this purpose in the amount of \$154,045.00.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 14TH, day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,766.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 161.0 [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
