RESOLUTION NO. 98-142

WHEREAS, Safe Ride Services submitted a collaborative Agreement to the Health & Human Services Committee on Monday, April 13, 1998; and


WHEREAS, the Health & Human Services Committee, Office of Attorney General, Executive Office and other parties need to review the said agreement; and

WHEREAS, a thirty day extension would allow for such a review and forward to the Nation for final approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the thirty (30) day extension.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 16TH day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,695.0 FOR; 71.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 161.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


