9		political integrity and economic security of the Nation, and the health,
10		safety and welfare of its members and all persons present on the lands
11		of the Nation; and
12	WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council ("Legislative Council")
13		adopted the Solid Waste Management Code and Solid Waste
14		Management Plan on February 12, 1997 and amended the Solid Waste
15		Management Code on October 16, 1997; and
16	WHEREAS,	the Solid Waste Code directs the Solid Waste Management Program to
17		implement a system of collection and disposal of solid waste,
18		including the management of household hazardous waste; and
19	WHEREAS,	for the Solid Waste Management Program to be successful it is very
20		important to educate the O'odham People on the importance of
21		proper disposal of their solid waste and household hazardous waste;

24	WHEREAS,	the Solid Waste Management Program has prepared a grant proposal
25		requesting \$99,676.00 from the Environmental Protection Agency for
26		a two year period to educate the O'odham People about household
27		hazardous waste, pollution prevention and proper disposal and clean-
