

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving of the Community Based Diabetes Prevention Program Data  
Improvement Proposal and Budget for Fiscal Year 1998)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-150**

**WHEREAS, Indian Health Service (I.H.S.) has announced the availability of funds for noncompetitive grants under a special Diabetes program for Indians, authorized by the Balanced Budget Act; and**

**WHEREAS, approximately \$33 million is available nationally per year for the next five years to address diabetes prevention and treatment; and**

**WHEREAS, the nine (9) I.H.S. Areas did make recommendations for the distribution of these dollars; and**

**WHEREAS, the allocation for the Tohono O'odham Nation is \$536,942.52, and;**

**WHEREAS, an added \$116,000 is allocated to the Tohono O'odham Nation for data improvement; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Health and Human Service has developed the attached proposal for the use of the \$116,000 allocation for the data improvement.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:**

- 1. Approves data improvement proposal and budget of \$116,000.**
- 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit; the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant and expend such funds when received.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,652.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 275.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




