3 **WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc., submitted a proposal to the**
4 **Arizona Department of Economic Security, Aging and Adult**
5 **Administration for tobacco tax dollars to offer non medical home and**
6 **community based services; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) is a member of the Inter-Tribal**
8 **Council of Arizona, Inc.; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the program is entitled the "Tribal Elders Home Adaptation and**
10 **Renovation Project" or TEHARP; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Nation is one of four Indian communities which submitted**
12 **information for the grant application; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the project goal is to enable tribal elders to remain in their own home**
14 **by improving conditions which will increase their mobility, safety and**
15 **access at home; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Nation has been selected for an award of \$8,750.00 from July 1,**
17 **1997 to June 30, 1998; and**

18 **WHEREAS, this grant will be incorporated in the existing grant with Inter-Tribal**
19 **Council of Arizona; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Chairman of the Nation has the authority to negotiate, execute and**
21 **expend the funds as necessary.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
23 **hereby accepts, approves and authorizes expenditures of the Tribal**
24 **Elder Home Adaptation and Renovation Project (TEHARP) to enable**
25 **elders to remain in their homes with dignity and in reasonable**
26 **comfort for as long as possible.**
