1 $\mathbf{2}$ **RESOLUTION NO. 98-152** 3 WHEREAS, the Indian Child Protection and Family Violence Prevention Act of 4 1990, 25 USC §§ 320 et seq., authorizes the use of multi-disciplinary 5 teams to address the many issues in child abuse and neglect cases; and 6 WHEREAS, efforts have been made within the Tohono O'odham Nation to 7 establish such a team: and 8 WHEREAS, these efforts have been made using existing personnel and have not 9 been successful due to staffing and funding constraints; and 10 WHEREAS, each of the agencies participating on the team is committed to 11 working cooperatively; and 12 WHEREAS, the Children Justice Task Force has offered \$15,000 to support a 13 consultant contract for a qualified individual to design and develop a 14 protocol for our multi-disciplinary team. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council: 16 1. Approves the funding from the Children Justice Task Force for a 17 18 consultant contract to develop a protocol for the multi-19 disciplinary team. **20** The Tohono O'odham Nation's officials to wit: the Chairman and 21Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized **22** to negotiate and execute the grant, and to expend such funds when **23** received. **24** The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 17TH. day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of **25** 1,813.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the **26** powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18. 27 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 28 Stat. 984).
