

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-163

WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy assistance funds have been made available to the Tohono O'odham Nation for FY 1999 through the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does meet the eligibility requirements to operate a Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to apply for FY 1999 Low Income Home Energy Assistance funds to assist eligible families with utility assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to secure funding for provision of services during fiscal year 1999.

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services has submitted for review and approval a scope of work and budget that will conform to the eligibility criteria set for in the funding and reporting regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,

- 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorize the officials of the Tohono O'odham Nation to submit a request for Low Income Home Energy Assistance Funding from the State of Arizona, Department of Commerce and authorizes expenditures in accordance to the attached budget.**
- 2. That the duration of the grant shall be from July 01, 1998 through June 30, 1999.**
- 3. That the Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract.**

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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 24TH day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
