

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Amphitheater School District request for Funding the Native American
Student in the Research Paper/Project)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-166

**WHEREAS, O'odham students attend the Amphitheater School District in
northwest Tucson; and**

**WHEREAS, the O'odham high school students are experiencing difficulties with
the research paper/project, required by the Amphitheater School
District; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation recognizes the need for students to
become proficient in writing, as well as other basic skills; and**

**WHEREAS, the Native American Education Department and the Amphitheater
School District has proposed a summer school program to assist
fifteen O'odham students with the Research Paper/Project; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Committee and the appropriate
Legislative Council Committees have reviewed this proposal and are
in support of this project.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
hereby agrees to fund the Amphitheater School District's Native
American Research Paper/Project in the amount of \$4,250.00.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
recognizes the appropriation of funds to the Amphitheater School
District Research Paper/Project will be reimbursed to the Tohono
O'odham Nation if it meets the criteria of the O'odham Charitable
Organization as approved by Initiative IN-01-97.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 24TH
day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0
FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in
the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved
by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,
1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**




