18	hereby agrees to fund the Amphitheater School District's Native
19	American Research Paper/Project in the amount of \$4,250.00.
20	BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
21	recognizes the appropriation of funds to the Amphitheater School
22	District Research Paper/Project will be reimbursed to the Tohono
23	O'odham Nation if it meets the criteria of the O'odham Charitable
24	Organization as approved by Initiative IN-01-97.
