6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation signed a Cooperative Agreement with**
7 **United States Environmental Protection Agency, Region IX to**
8 **implement and develop a Superfund Preliminary Assessment/Site**
9 **Inspection (PA/SI) and a CORE program; and**


10 **WHEREAS, the original project period was October 01, 1996 to September 30,**
11 **1998; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the EPA, Region IX granted a newly extended project period to be**
13 **October 01, 1996 to June 30, 1999.**

14 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
15 **hereby approves the Superfund Block Cooperative Agreement grant**
16 **extension.**

17 **The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 24TH,**
18 **day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of**
19 **1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers**
20 **vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono**
21 **O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and**
22 **approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on**
23 **March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


