(Authority for the Administration for Native Americans Grant Proposal  
for Governance - Land Use Planning)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 98-169**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is dedicated to the development of improved long range planning for land use and development of the Nation's social and economic resources for the betterment of the Nation's people and their future; and**

**WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning Process project is the best first step in the process of improving the Nation's interests for a well planned future; and**

**WHEREAS, the Administration for Native Americans has a grant opportunity to fund the Nation's Land Use Planning Process project in the 1998 funding cycle; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation, through its people, its Chairman and its Legislative Council has mandated a need for this proposed land use planning process in the peoples consensus on and the Legislative Council's acceptance and adoption of the Chairman's Administrative Plan, with regard to land use planning; and**

**WHEREAS, the Land Use Planning Process project will be a three year project in the amount of \$391,384.54 for the first year, \$388,588.08 for the second year and \$387,845.65 for the third year - a total of \$1,167,818.27; and**

**WHEREAS, the general population of the Tohono O'odham Nation has been involved in the development of this project and will be a central part of the project in the form of input, participation in meetings, participation in the development of the planning process and participation in community and District meetings; and**

- 4. The Chairpersons of the Districts of the Tohono O'odham Nation;**
- 5. The Village Representatives from each of the communities of the Tohono O'odham Nation;**

- 7. The Tohono O'odham Utility Authority;**
- 8. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council;**
- 9. The Tohono O'odham Natural Resources Department;**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby commits, supports and approves the application to the Administration for Native Americans (ANA) for a SEDS grant to assist the Tohono O'odham Nation in the Land Use Planning Process project, which will be a three year project in the total amount of \$1,167,818.27.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 24TH day of APRIL, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,605.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 322.0 NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
