**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation approved a supplemental budget for the Credit and Finance Program as part of the Executive Branch Budget; and**

**WHEREAS, the Credit and Finance Program has experienced savings in its Federal Budget and can shift anticipated expenses to that source of funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the program wishes to modify its program operations to expand and provide new services to its clients; and**

**WHEREAS, the Credit and Finance Program has submitted a request to modify its budget that accounts for these savings and reallocates its appropriated budget into line items that support these operating changes.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation that Modification One to the Credit and Finance Supplemental Budget is approved.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Credit and Finance Program Tribal Base Budget for FY 1999 is unaffected by this modification to the FY 1998 budget.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 4TH day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,766.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 161.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
