

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Budget Modification #1 for the Office of the Prosecutor)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-181

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is fully authorized to act on behalf of our members in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. seq., (hereinafter the Act); and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is empowered to act for and on behalf of its Tohono O'odham Members in adopting resolutions; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor has submitted Budget Modification #1 for approval by the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor has a need to reallocate funds within its FY 97/98 budget; and

WHEREAS, funds from line items 650 (Tuition & Registration) and 857 (Payments to Victims and Witnesses) will be reallocated to line items 711 (Communication Expense), 720 (Supplies-Office), 721 (Supplies-Other), and 852 (Donation/Contribution); and

WHEREAS, the Office of the Prosecutor does not currently have line item 852 (Donation/Contribution) in its FY 97/98 budget.

WHEREAS, this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as this resolution has been fully completed, expressly rescinded or modified by the Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council hereby establishes line item 852 (Donation/Contribution) for the


