

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Support and Monetary Contributions for Baboquivari and Desert View
High School Students to travel to Russia)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-184

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the achievements and accomplishments of our O'odham youth; and

WHEREAS, ten (10) students and one chaperone from the Baboquivari High School and eight (8) students and one chaperone from the Desert View High School will be participating in a cultural exchange with the Country of Russia, City of Krasnoyarsk, from June 28, 1998 to July 20, 1998; and

WHEREAS, support and monetary assistance in the amount of \$11,000 for Baboquivari High School and \$9,000 for Desert View High School (\$1,000 per person) for a combined total of \$20,000 is being requested for per diem for the following participants and respective districts:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes that the appropriation of funds to Baboquivari and Desert View High School Students and two chaperones for participation in the Russia Cultural Exchange will be reimbursed to the Tohono O'odham Nation if it meets the criteria of the O'odham Charitable Organization as approved by Initiative IN-01-97.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,854.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 73.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
