

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving CAP Link Pipeline and Design Review of the Farm
Rehabilitation Plan)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-188

WHEREAS, the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 provides that the existing irrigation system on the San Xavier Reservation will be improved and extended; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier Cooperative Association, Inc. (SXCA) in Resolutions 10-86-1, and 05-87-01 approved the San Xavier Cooperative Farm Rehabilitation Plan, which included the design and construction of the CAP Link Pipeline; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation's Legislative Council did likewise approve this Rehabilitation Plan in Resolution No. 218-87; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council through Resolution Nos. 11-86-02 and 05-87-01 supports the SXCA Farm Rehabilitation Plan; and

WHEREAS, there have been no actions taken to implement the planned rehabilitation work on the Co-op Farm for almost twelve years; and

WHEREAS, the SXCA has requested that the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) initiate actions that would lead to the rehabilitation of the Co-op Farm and construction of the CAP Link Pipeline (Res. No. 07-96); and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier District Council supports the SXCA in their efforts to implement farm rehabilitation, including the construction of the CAP Link; and

WHEREAS, the San Xavier Council wishes to assist the SXCA by preparing and entering into a Cooperative Agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation for the review, planning and final design and

construction of the CAP Link Pipeline and the design review of the Farm Rehabilitation Plan for the San Xavier Cooperative farm (Res. No. 05-98-05).


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the proposal for the CAP Link Pipeline and the Design Review of the Farm Rehabilitation Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby grants authority to the San Xavier District Council to prepare a Cooperative Agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation for the review, planning, and final design and construction of the CAP Link Pipeline and the design review of the Farm Rehabilitation Plan for the San Xavier Cooperative Farm.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Cooperative Agreement with the Bureau of Reclamation will require approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,166.5 FOR; 545.5 AGAINST; 73.0 NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) & (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
