1 2 RESOLUTION NO. 98-191 3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation JTPA/NEW program has received 4 instructions for the submittal of the 1998 Comprehensive Annual Plan 5 to the U.S. Department of Labor for the period beginning July 1, 1998 6 through June 30, 1999; and 7 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is eligible for funding in the amount of 8 9 \$459,405.00; and 10 WHEREAS, the deadline for submittal of the plan is May 8, 1998. 11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Tohono O'odham Legislative 12 Council does hereby approve the submittal of the Tohono O'odham 13 Nation's Title IVA Comprehensive Annual Plan for 1998. 14 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JTPA/NEW program will submit the finalized 15 plan along with a budget upon completion of committee reviews and 16 approvals. 17 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the 18 Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit; the Chairman and any 19 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the **20** contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the 21 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for 22 23 further prior approval by this council. 24 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>08TH.</u> day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.785.0 25FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(1), (2) & (3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the **26** Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs 27 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 28 Stat. 984).
