1 $\mathbf{2}$ RESOLUTION NO. 98-194 3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation JTPA/NEW Program has submitted the 4 1998 Department of Labor Summer Youth Employment Plan for the 5 period beginning on October 1, 1997 through September 30,1998; and 6 WHEREAS, the Summer Youth Plan estimates serving approximately 177 youth 7 between the ages of 14 and 21 years in activities such as the San Xavier 8 Bee Population Project, Pima College Summer Academies, Pima 9 College Upward Bound, and various work experience opportunities 10 11 throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation; and 12 WHEREAS, the program has prepared budgets for administrative costs, 13 classroom training, training assistance, employment costs and 14 support services with all budgets totaling \$300,018.00. 15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 16 does hereby approve the 1998 JTPA/NEW Summer Youth Employment 17 Plan and budgets. 18 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the 19 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, and any 20 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the 21 contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the 22 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for 23 24 further prior approval by this Council. 25 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the <u>08TH</u>. day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1.785.0 **26** FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono 27 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and

approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on

March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
