17	workers and residents of all three tribal farms by protecting their well
18	being; and

20	WHEREAS, the Nation will also benefit by preserving and maintaining the
21	Nation's land; and
22	WHEREAS, if this grant is awarded, implementation and assessment will be
23	conducted by the Planning & Economic Development Department/
24	Environmental Office.
