**WHEREAS, the EPA Office of Pesticide Program has announced the availability of
Cooperative Agreement Funds under the Federal Insecticide,
Fungicide, and Rodenticide Act for Tribal Pesticide Projects; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has three Tribal Farms, Papago, Vaivo Vo
and San Lucy, where approximately 20 families reside and 40 on-site
workers are employed; and**

**WHEREAS, the Cooperative Agreement Funds would assist the Nation by
performing soil and ground water sampling to determine whether
pesticide contamination exists due the length of time pesticide
applications occurred; and**

**WHEREAS, the soil and ground water sampling project will benefit the on-site
workers and residents of all three tribal farms by protecting their well
being; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation will also benefit by preserving and maintaining the
Nation's land; and**

**WHEREAS, if this grant is awarded, implementation and assessment will be
conducted by the Planning & Economic Development Department/
Environmental Office.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative
Council hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Project
Proposal to the EPA Office of Pesticide Program.**
