RESOLUTION NO. 98-199

**WHEREAS, the A'al We:pek/Children First, Inc. is a drug and alcohol prevention
non-profit organization serving Tohono O'odham children, residing
on the San Xavier District of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, A'al We:pek/Children First is in constant competition with San Xavier
District programs for utilization of district vehicles; and**

**WHEREAS, monetary contribution for purchase of a 15-passenger van will
provide transportation for children for organization functions; and**

**WHEREAS, children need social interaction and to experience other educational
and recreational functions and to have fun, which this donation will
allow to happen.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
hereby donates \$40,099.00 pursuant to the aforementioned purposes.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
recognizes the appropriation of funds to A'al We:pek/Children First
will be reimbursed to the Tohono O'odham Nation if it meets the
criteria of the O'odham Charitable Organization as approved by
Initiative IN-01-97.**

day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,725.0
FOR; -0- AGAINST; 60.0 NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers
vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the
Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48
Stat. 984).**
