

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for American
Indians with Disabilities (130 Project))**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-202

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recognizes the personal value each individual derives from being a working member in the community; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is committed to enhancing the level of service to members of the Tohono O'odham Nation who due to a disability may face additional challenges to obtaining and maintaining employment; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Education Department has responded to a federal request inviting applications for new awards under the Vocational Rehabilitation Services Projects for American Indians with Disabilities (130 Project) by writing a grant proposal that if funded will establish the Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program which will assist all Native Americans with disabilities living on the Tohono O'odham Nation to develop and maintain meaningful employment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the Education Department's grant proposal to establish a Tohono O'odham Vocational Rehabilitation Program and authorizes the Chairman of the Nation to submit the proposal and sign as necessary documents and assurances to accompany the proposal.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 08TH day of MAY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,785.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


