7 **Tohono O'odham Communities for youth; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Junior Rodeo provides an opportunity for the public, especially**
9 **parents and guardians to take pride in their children as they**
10 **participate; and**

11 **WHEREAS, as a result of the loss of Ronald L. Manuel, Jr. on July 17, 1994, the**
12 **family chose to honor his memory at the same time providing a**
13 **positive activity for all youth by sponsoring an Annual Junior Rodeo;**

15 **WHEREAS, a voluntary fund raising committee was established to pursue fund**
16 **raising efforts throughout the year; and**

17 **WHEREAS, not half of the required total budget was raised thus resulting in this**
18 **request for a monetary contribution from the Tohono O'odham**
19 **Legislative Council in the amount of Five Thousand Dollars (\$5,000.00).**

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 03RD day of JUNE, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 946.0 FOR; 835.0 AGAINST; 146.0 NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
