

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the Submittal of the Tohono O'odham Nation NEW Program Plan
for FY 1998)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-231

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has received planning guidance and instructions for the Fiscal Year 1998 NEW Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been determined eligible to receive funding for the Native Employment Works Program; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is eligible to receive a three year grant in the amount of \$150,868.00 each year; and

WHEREAS, the services provided through the Native Employment Works Program will assist individuals in upgrading job skills and to actively seek employment on a permanent basis; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will greatly benefit from these individuals when they are trained and are employable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the submittal of the Tohono O'odham Nation NEW Program plan for Fiscal Year 1998 by the JTPA/NEW Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the JTPA/NEW Program will submit the finalized NEW plan along with a budget upon completion of committee reviews and approvals.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendment affecting the funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
