

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 98 Judicial Services Budget Modification #1 Increase)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-240

WHEREAS, on May 21, 1998 the Judicial Branch was notified that the FY 98 Judicial Service contract under the Master Contract No. 1450CTH54T61071 received an allocation increase of \$16,979.00; and

WHEREAS, the Judicial Branch has submitted a budget modification for review and approval to the Judiciary Committee on June 11, 1998 and to the Budget & Finance Committee on June 18, 1998; and

WHEREAS, this budget modification will provide the necessary equipment to process cases and to coordinate a productive case management system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Judicial Branch is authorized to accept and use the Increase to the FY 98 Judicial Service Contract in accordance with this modification.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 26TH, day of JUNE, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
