

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of Re-application of Department of Human Services/Division of
Child Welfare Services - FY99 Title IV-B Child Welfare Service Subpart 1
and Promoting Safe and Stable Families, Subpart 2, Social Security Act)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-241

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has always had a desire to provide for the health and welfare needs of O'odham children and families; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Child Welfare Services has the primary responsibility to provide for those families found to be in the need of such care; and

WHEREAS, the Title IV-B, Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act provides funds for development of a five year plan for demonstrating effective prevention approaches for handling increasing family problems under specified terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, in FY 1995 a five year plan was submitted by the Human Services/Child Welfare Division and reviewed and approved by Executive and Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, Title IV-B, Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 require yearly re-application for funds to support the five year plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

- 1. It does approve the re-application of the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services to continue the implementation of the updated Five Year Plan with some modification as needed.**
- 2. Approve the Title IV-B application funding in the amount of \$50,062 for Subpart I and \$37,126 for Subpart II.**

3. That the budget period coverage is FY99 (October 1, 1998 - September 30, 1999).

4. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 26TH day of JUNE, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
