

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approval of FY 1999 Women, Infants and Children Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-243

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for women, infants and children during the Fiscal Year 1998; and

WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United States Department of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit women, infants and children; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum of Agreement with Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to fund and operate the Women, Infants and Children (WIC) Program which commenced on October 01, 1997 through September 30, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the health of individuals at risk.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Nation hereby approves the proposal for funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to continue to operate and provide services to eligible women, infants and children.**
- 2. The Memorandum of Agreement shall continue through September 30, 2001.**
- 3. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials to wit, the Chairman and Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute contracts associated with this program and to expend funds when received.**
