

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1999 Food Distribution Program-Budget Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-245

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Food Distribution Program under an FY 1998 Grant with the United States Department of Agriculture; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to renew for provisions for services; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the FY 1999 Food Distribution Program proposal and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does authorize and request the United States Department of Agriculture to renew with the Tohono O'odham Nation for provision of services titled: Food Distribution Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant shall be from October 01, 1998 and as long as there is funding for the Food Distribution Program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed grant has been approved by the United States Department of Agriculture.



13 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


