1 $\mathbf{2}$ **RESOLUTION NO. 98-252** 3 4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, through the enactment of 5 Resolution 98-223 Authorizing the Establishment of Cash collateral for 6 the 1998 Crop Loan in the Form of a Security Deposit with Anderson 7 Clayton Co., did authorize the transfer of funds from one of the 8 Nation's investment account to implement the provisions of the 9 resolution; and 10 WHEREAS, the Accounting Department has advised the Council that the identified 11 account, IC1067503, has an insufficient balance to fully implement 12 Resolution 98-223; and 13 WHEREAS, the department has presented to the Investment Committee the 14 15 identification of other investment accounts with sufficient balances: 16 and 17 WHEREAS, the Investment Committee has reviewed and approved alternate 18 sources from which funds could be drawn in order to implement 19 resolution 98-223; and 20 WHEREAS, resolution 98-223 made reference to Anderson Clayton Co. as the 21 financial institution with whom the Nation will be negotiating; and 22 WHEREAS, the Nation has been advised by Anderson Clayton Co. that the Nation 23 will be negotiating with its financial subsidiary, ACCO Finance and has 24 requested a clarification. 25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 26 that the Chairman of the Nation is hereby authorized to transfer the 27 28 following amounts from the identified accounts to implement the
