12		these funds be used for standby projects covering existing paved
13		roads, or sections thereof, that are in need of chip sealing or asphaltic
14		concrete resurfacing, require little or no archeological and
15		environmental work, can be put together with little or no survey and
16		design work, and for which BIA has right-of -way. Two such projects
17		have been identified for the Tohono O'odham Nation. These projects
