

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Authorizing the BIA Phoenix Area Office to Expend FY 1998 Funds for
Road Construction Activities)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-257

**WHEREAS, President Clinton signed the Transportation Equity Act for the 21st
Century which increased the annual funding for Indian Reservation
Roads Program; and**

**WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area Office has therefore been
instructed to expend additional funds for FY 1998 roads construction
activities; and**

**WHEREAS, the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Phoenix Area Office has proposed that
these funds be used for standby projects covering existing paved
roads, or sections thereof, that are in need of chip sealing or asphaltic
concrete resurfacing, require little or no archeological and
environmental work, can be put together with little or no survey and
design work, and for which BIA has right-of -way. Two such projects
have been identified for the Tohono O'odham Nation. These projects
are described as follows:**

**PIR Chip Seal No. 1 (87.3 miles). This project consists of chip
sealing and rubber chip sealing the following sections of road:**

Chip Seal

IR 3, from SR 86 to Gunsight

IR 30, from SR 86 to Ko Vaya

IR 232, from IR 30 to San Luis Village

IR 30, from SR 86 to Comobabi

**IR 301 (San Xavier Dist.), from Mission Rd. to San Xavier Rd./6th
Ave. Extension**

IR 400 (San Lucy Dist.), San Lucy Village Streets

Rubber Chip Seal

IR 1, from SR 86 to Menegar's Dam

IR 15, from SR 86 to Santa Rosa Village

IR 15, from Cypress Mine turnoff to North Reservation Boundary

The estimated cost of this project is \$3,000,000.

PIR 34 (7)(16 Miles). This project consist of cold recycling and hot asphalt-rubber chip sealing BIA Route 34 (Hickiwan Road) from the turn-off to Ventana to Hickiwan, and Route 103, in Vaya Chin.

The estimated cost of this project is \$1,500,000.

WHEREAS, these projects are in addition to those priorities already funded in FY 1998; and

WHEREAS, these funds will not be available in the future.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby authorize the BIA Phoenix Area Office to expend FY 1998 funds for the projects named herein.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of JUNE, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
