

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Adopting the Indian Housing Plan)**

4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is prepared to meet the housing**  
5 **responsibilities of its people, and will exercise the right of Indian Self-**  
6 **Determination and Self-Governance, similar to P.L. 93-638, as set-**  
7 **forth in the Native American Housing Assistance and Self-**  
8 **Determination Act of 1996, NAHASDA; and**

9 **WHEREAS, the NAHASDA, P.L. 104-330 Act revamps all Indian Housing programs**  
10 **nationwide, and will now serve Native American Housing needs under**  
11 **a Block Grant funding system; and**

12  
13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has by separate Ordinance No. 98-03**  
14 **designated the Tohono O'odham Ki:ki Association as the Tribally**  
15 **Designated Housing Entity (TDHE); and**

16 **WHEREAS, the TDHE's primary responsibility will be to provide affordable**  
17 **housing for low income O'odham, as well as other related affordable**  
18 **housing activities; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the TDHE will also be able to provide housing assistance to non-low**  
21 **income O'odham and O'odham members that reside off reservation;**  
22 **and**

23 **WHEREAS, the NAHASDA was intended to give as much flexibility and Self-**  
24 **Determination similar to Self-Governance Tribes.**

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Ki:ki Association**  
26 **is herein authorized to utilize resources and funding from the private,**  
27 **and public sectors to benefit the housing needs of our people.**



**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29TH day of JUNE, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,605.0 FOR; 322.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
