

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(BIA/Tribal Budget System Priority Ranking for FY 2000)**

RESOLUTION NO. 98-264

WHEREAS, the BIA Papago Agency presented to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council the projected FY 2000 Planning Base Amounts under the Tribal Priority Allocations of the Bureau budget for FY 2000; and

WHEREAS, the Papago Agency submitted the Tribal Priority Allocation programs, and Funding Allocation Levels to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Priority Rankings provide the Tohono O'odham Nation the opportunity to participate in the Federal Budget formulation process for the allocation and ranking of resources available under the Tribal Priority Allocations; and

WHEREAS, the rankings depict the Nation's priorities as previously established; and


WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the proposed FY 2000 Planning Base Amounts and Priority Ranking Numbers as submitted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Projected Planning Base Amounts and Rankings under the Tribal Priority Allocations of the Bureau budget be adopted for FY 2000.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH, day of JULY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,704.5 FOR; 222.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c)(2), (f), & (j), of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




