- It hereby approves the submission of the Elder Health Care Proposal for year two.
- 2. The Tohono O'odham Nation Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute contracts associated with this grant and to expend funds when received.
