**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is currently operating the Tohono  
O'odham Psychological Services Treatment Program for the Seriously  
Mentally Ill Tas Tonlik Ki Day Program through a P.L. 93-638 grant;  
and**

**WHEREAS, the SMI Program has submitted a budget for \$200,000.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:**

- 1. That the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves  
the attached FY 1999 Psychological Services - SMI Day Program  
Tas Tonlik Ki Day Program Budget in the amount of \$200,000.**
- 2. That the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the  
Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated Officer are hereby  
authorized to negotiate and execute the proposal and expend  
funds when received.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 06TH  
day of JULY, 1998 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,927.0  
FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested  
in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and  
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on  
March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
